Secretary's Report

A business meeting of The Southeast Bus Nuts (SEBN) convened at Barnyard RV Resort on Saturday, May 1, 2021. The meeting was called to order by President Manny Montesino. Devotion was led by Darlene Montesino. Pledge of Allegiance to the United States flag was led by FMCA Director Rick Bartley. The following members were recognized: Herb Bates was in a recent car accident, Jim and Cynthia

Threatt have both been sick, Vicky Daniels in the loss of her mother and Leonard and Pam Jelkren on the tragic loss of their son Bradley. Darlene Montesino led the members in prayer, and subsequently provided a social media update.

Secretary Ron Daniels read the minutes from past business meeting. Mike Heron shared a Treasurers re-

port on behalf of Treasurer Craig Bowen with \$207.00 in PayPal account and \$6408. in our checking account for a total of \$6615.

Ron Daniels also reported the membership includes 50 active members (41 regular, 9 honorary). He encouraged all members to review the Chapter website and update addresses, phone numbers and email addresses as applicable, and to be sure and keep Family Motor Coach Association (FMCA) membership current. SEBN was annually recertified with FMCA on 11-19-2020. A dues due reminder email was sent out on 3-22-2021 to delinquent members. Our name tag vendor passed away and his wife closed the business. A search for a new vendor is underway. FMCA Chapters are required to link their websites to FMCA.com in order to be covered under FMCA media liability insurance, SEBN website links only responds to Safari browser but not to Google, Firefox, Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge.

Denise Aldridge, Vice President /Rally Master, led a discussion of upcoming rallies. The Fall rally is October 7- 10^{th} in Marianna, Florida with **Marty Nixon** and **Kaydee Black** as hosts. A return to the Cabana Club, Florida is set on January $6-9^{th}$, 2022 with Manny and

Darlene Montesino as rally hosts. A discussion was held about a possible rally in March, 2022 in conjunction with FMCA National Convention in Perry, Georgia. A possible Fall 2022 rally in Hartsell, Alabama is being examined.

Special tribute to our late Past President

The Wright Brothers Master Pilot Award is an annual award presented by the FAA to deserving pilots who have achieved a total of 50 + years of exemplary aviation flight experience. Application for Charlie Bukoski's award was suggested by a fellow instructor and previous recipient. The process goes thru numerous steps including the FAA obtaining all flight records, both military and civilian. Once reviewed, the pilot (or in my case, his widow) is notified when the application is accepted. Pictures and articles are then collected and sent to the FAA representative in preparation for a

presentation ceremony. The live ceremony was to have taken place at Sun n Fun 2020, but due to Covid, the show was cancelled. It took place on May 4, 2021, which would have been Charlie's 80th Birthday. Multiple fellow Air Force and civilian pilots as well as multiple family members and friends were notified in advance



and around 30 folks joined in. Following the presentation and video of Charlie's flying 50+ year history, there was interaction among those present for a time of fellowship and a few laughs. It was like a reunion to see all those faces once again!
